POINTS AWARDED

PREVIOUS APPLICATION TO MCSRT**MAXIMUM POINTS = 4**

Prior applicants may earn up to 4 points by following these steps:

- Initiate a counseling procedure with MCSRT faculty after prior denial
- Follow-through and complete suggestions made during counseling procedure
- Provide necessary documentation as evidence of completion

POINTS AWARDED

APPLICANT SEMINAR AND CAREER ORIENTATION**MAXIMUM POINTS = 6**

Up to 6 points can be awarded based on:

- Adaptability to radiologic profession as evidenced by applicant asking relevant questions and professional interaction with healthcare/radiologic staff.
- Written response assignment.

HEALTHCARE/PATIENT CARE EXPERIENCE**MAXIMUM POINTS = 5**

POINTS AWARDED

INTERVIEW**MAXIMUM POINTS = 50**

Up to 50 points can be awarded for the Interview phase of the selection process. The purpose is to give equal opportunity for all applicants to demonstrate their suitability to the radiology profession. The Selection Committee will ask questions that are designed to help the candidate bring out valuable traits that are not a natural part of application paperwork. Following is a synopsis of the main points covered in the interview:

- An understanding of the profession of Radiologic Technology
- Reasons for applying to our program to become a Radiologic Technologist
- Financial provisions for cost of the program
- Time management
- Maturity
- Adaptable behavior
- Communication ability
- Critical thinking skills
- Multi-tasking ability
- Poise and professionalism

TOTAL SELECTION POINTS
