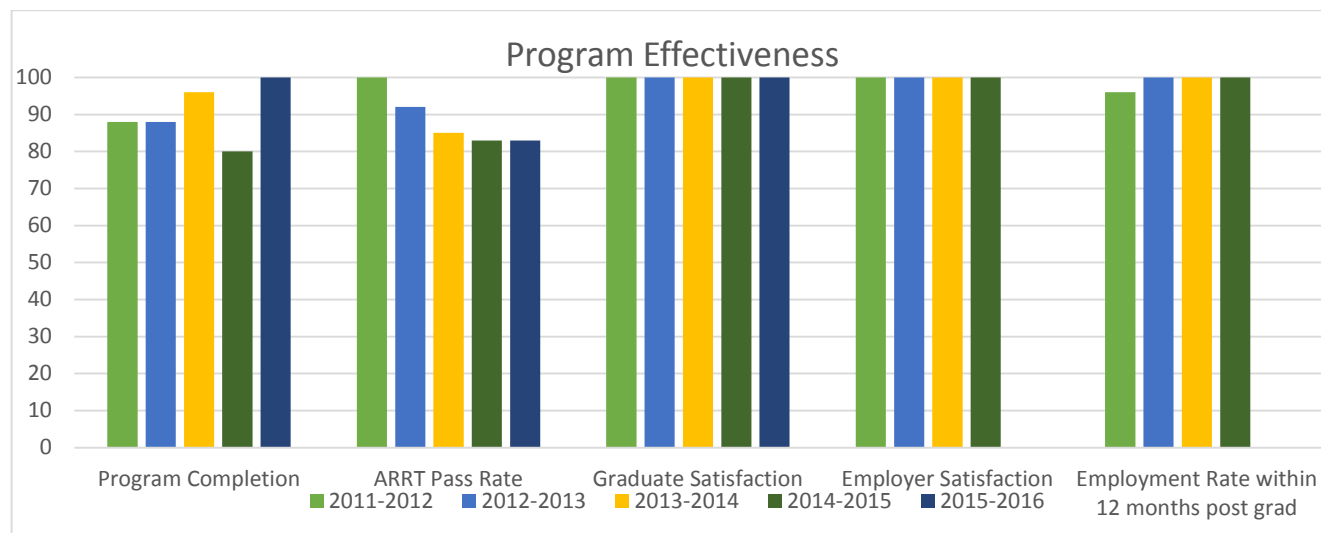


Radiologic Technology Program 2011 - 2016 Accreditation and Program Effectiveness Data

The Radiologic Technology program at Marion Technical College (MTC) is accredited by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is nationally accepted for setting standards for education in radiography. Graduates from this accredited program take national board exams administered by the American Registry for Radiologic Technologists (ARRT). ARRT is accepted as the credentialing agency for radiographers in the United States. The performance of this program is reflected through program effectiveness data as defined by the JRCERT. Program effectiveness data includes the program's completion rate, credentialing examination pass rate and job placement rate as illustrated below.



2011 - 2016 Five-Year Average Program Completion Rate / Credentialing Exam Pass Rate / Job Placement Rate

Program completion rate = the number of students who complete the program within a cohort compared to the number who enrolled in the cohort initially.

Credentialing examination pass rate = The number of graduates who pass, on first attempt, the credentialing examination administered by the American Registration for Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) compared with the number of graduates taking the examination within six months of graduation.

Job placement rate = The number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences, within 12 months of graduation, compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.
