<p><b>Application Eligibility</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completion of an Associate’s Degree (or higher) - AAS, AS, or AA degree from an institution accredited by a regional accreditation agency are acceptable. (Degree Major is unspecified)</li> <li>• Minimum 2.75 GPA at completion of degree.</li> <li>• Ability to meet Program’s published Technical Standards.</li> <li>• Required as either part of the degree or additional courses taken:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- College Algebra</li> <li>- Anatomy &amp; Physiology I (w/Lab)</li> <li>- Anatomy &amp; Physiology II (w/Lab)</li> <li>- Medical Terminology</li> <li>- Microcomputer Applications</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: fit-content; margin-left: auto; margin-right: auto;"> <p><i>Make appointment with Program Director to discuss acceptable substitutions.</i></p> </div>

<p><b>Application Timeline</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>January 1 – May 15:</b> Submit Application Package including:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Official College Transcripts (from every college attended)</li> <li>- High School Transcripts</li> <li>- 3 Recommendation Forms from professional sources (mailed separately by persons completing the forms).</li> <li>- Marion Technical College Application must ALSO be submitted to Student Services (\$15 fee)</li> </ul> <p><u>Early application with UNOFFICIAL transcript is encouraged; however, final OFFICIAL transcript MUST be submitted by 5/15.</u></p> </li> <li>• <b>March-May:</b> Applicants scheduled for Seminar, Career Observation Tour, and Faculty Dialogues. All applicants receive notification via email.</li> <li>• <b>May-June:</b> Notifications made for acceptance or denial.</li> <li>• <b>Mid July:</b> Program Orientation for selected students.</li> <li>• <b>August:</b> Program (classes) begin.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Applicant Acceptance</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Radiologic Technology is a limited access/selected admission program.</li> <li>• Selection is made on a point-scale basis. The point-scale criteria may be downloaded from <a href="http://ctae.edu/radiologic_technology">ctae.edu/radiologic_technology</a>.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 50% based on academic performance</li> <li>- 40% based on Faculty Dialogues/Interview</li> <li>- 10% Other (prior healthcare experience, prior application, Applicant Tour)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Financial Aid</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete FAFSA at <a href="http://www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> School Code: <b>031039</b></li> <li>• Scholarships and grants are available to qualifying students. Contact the Financial Aid Office at MTC (352)671-7200.</li> <li>• The Radiography Program does NOT qualify for GI Bill status due to curriculum that incorporates hybrid education.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Background Check Drug Screening</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Selected students will be required to undergo a criminal background check and drug screening.</li> <li>• The student incurs the cost of background check and drug screen.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Health Screening</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Selected students will be required to submit a health certificate and immunization records (signed by a healthcare provider). Forms are provided in students’ acceptance letter.</li> </ul>
