## 2017 - 2018 Marion Technical College Financial Aid Application

Please make sure all necessary documentation and eligibility requirements below are met.  
Incomplete or non-eligible applications will not be processed or considered.

### Part 1 Documents Required

1. Completed Marion Technical College Financial Aid Application.
2. Proof of Florida residency. A residency affidavit must be signed and on file with the Student Services Department upon admission to ensure in state tuition eligibility.
3. A **current error free 17-18 FAFSA application for a Federal Pell Grant must be on file in the financial aid office.** The EFC generated by your FAFSA will be used to determine your eligibility for Marion Technical College Financial Aid. Eligibility for a Pell grant is not required. I have successfully completed my 17-18 FAFSA listing school code 031039 as a school of interest on \_\_\_\_\_
4. Valid Standard High School Diploma, GED or equivalent. An official high school completion or college degree transcript must be on file with the Student Services Department.

### Part 2 Eligibility Requirements and Financial Aid Information

#### Financial Aid Award Level EFC Range

<b>0-10000 may qualify for \$3.00 per clock hour</b>
<b>10001-20000 may qualify for \$1.50 per clock hour</b>

1. A student may qualify for Marion Technical College Financial Aid based on EFC. Funds may be awarded based on the award schedule above to those students in
  - **Non-Pell eligible PSAV programs (programs less than 600 clock hours)**
  - **Pell eligible PSAV programs: Students that are either not eligible for Pell funding or that are eligible for Pell funding that have an out of pocket cost whose EFC exceeds 4701**

**Note: Students who qualify that have other aid may be adjusted based on amount of need not EFC range**

2. An error free FAFSA is required for all applicants as the EFC generated is used to determine eligibility. **Students selected for verification, must complete the verification process prior to any award.**
3. The student must **not be in default on any student loan(s) or owe a repayment on any Federal Grant.** The NSLDS database will be accessed to verify this. It is the responsibility of the student, to immediately inform the financial aid office of any change in information. The student's SSN will be used as an identifier.
4. **ALL STUDENTS RECEIVING Marion Technical College Financial Aid awards INCUR A PORTION OF THE FEES.** Awards are calculated at the qualifying rate multiplied by the number of clock hours in the program. For example: CNA program of 120 clock hours multiplied by \$3.00 per clock hour = \$660.00 in Marion Technical College Financial Aid funds, using the EFC range of 0-10000. Remaining course fees are the student's responsibility and must be paid in full prior to the first day of class, unless other payment arrangements have been made.
5. An award is granted for a specific program or class, in a specific academic year; however deferment vouchers are presented to students to review and sign each time a student registers.
6. Programs may need to be capped based on fund availability. The Marion Technical College Financial Aid Fund balance is reviewed annually, or as necessary to ensure fund sustainability.
7. The Financial Aid Administrator may amend this contract or awards as necessary on a case by case basis.
