Applicant Acceptance	<ul> <li>Radiography is a limited access/selected admission program. Selection is made on a point-scale basis. The Point-Scale Criteria is published at mariontc.edu/radiologic-technology.</li> <li>A minimum score of 55 is required for selection to the program.</li> <li>50% based on academic performance</li> <li>40% based on faculty dialogues</li> <li>10% Other (prior healthcare experience and/or certification, healthcare volunteerism, Career Observation Tour)</li> </ul>
