Application must be accompanied with the following documentation:

1. Current High School transcript. (An incomplete transcript is acceptable);
2. Two letters of recommendation attesting to your aptitude in the selected program;
3. Typed essay of 350-500 words. Choose from one of the following prompts:
 1. Describe a meaningful life achievement and its impact on your career goals;
 2. Pick a life experience and explain how it has shaped your work ethic.
4. Details of your activities in your CTSO, if applicable. Use space below.
