



The "ponosity" of the hair refers to how well moisture penetrates the cuticle layer of the hair shaft. This is a direct result of the way the cuticle layer rests along the hair shaft. In rormal hair, the cuticle cales certifica, but cales some moisture to penetrate the hair. In restlant that a compact cutcle layer has tightly overlapped scales and repels moisture. With ponous hair, the cuticle scales are reased and moisture passes easily hund and out of the hair shaft.
