Course Description: This curriculum is designed to deliver a comprehensive live fire training program, within a safe and controlled environment, in accordance with NFPA 1402, NFPA 1403, and NFPA 1500. Both lecture and practical will be used allowing participants to apply knowledge of the above standards to training activities. Participants will pre-plan existing props and participate in a live burn on the last day.

Course Prerequisites: Must be a Firefighter II and Instructor I or higher.

Course Dress Code: Students are representatives of the involved organizations and are to dress accordingly. The Florida State Fire College requires long pants, closed-toe shoes, and t-shirt.
