SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP)

- Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) is defined as the successful completion of coursework toward an eligible certificate or degree.
- Regulations require Financial Aid to monitor the academic progress of students receiving Title IV aid and Veterans Educational benefits.
 - Qualitative Measure (GPA)
 - Quantitative Measure (PACE)
 - Maximum Time Frame (Completion)

Monitored at each payment period



GPA: 2.0

PACE: Measured in hours AND weeks

MTF: 150% of scheduled hours

Attendance: 90% minimum

BASIC SKILLS REQUIREMENT

PERT TEST

- First attempt Required within 6 weeks
- One -time fee of \$15
- Several Exemptions to Basic Skills Requirements:
 - Program is less than 450 hours
 - Serving as an Active-Duty Member of the Military
 - PERT, ACT, SAT within last two years
 - Graduate of High School 2007 and beyond
 - Passed the 2014 GED
 - Associates Degree or Higher
- YOU DO NOT NEED TO PASS THIS EXAM TO STAY ENROLLED IN YOUR CTE PROGRAM
- IN MOST CASES, WHEN YOU PASS AN INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION, YOU WILL NOT NEED TO RETEST FOR THE PERT
- CALL OR STOP BY STUDENT SERVICES TO SCHEDULE YOUR PERT EXAM!



A.L.I.C.E. PROTOCOL DRILL

A.L.I.C.E. Protocol Drill

- This Safety Drill is different than the rest. This drill uses different classroom procedures for students in the event of an active threat on campus. The district, as well, as the nation, has mandated a specific protocol to use during this drill. It is called the A.L.I.C.E. Protocol.
- Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, and Evacuate (ALICE)
- The Marion County School District has implemented the Alice Protocol in the event of an active shooting.
